

Foreign exchange is the fuel of the Barbados economy. Tourism is the largest FX earner, with 49%. Other services account for 24%; manufactures and agricultural goods 12%; investment income and pensions 12% and remittances 3%.


Barbados has recovered its Market Share Figure 2. Barbados Arrivals and Caribbean


